### SHERWOOD SPECIAL ELECTION

#### BALLOT ISSUE

FOR or AGAINST the levy of a one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) Sales and Use Tax, the net collections of which remaining after the State of Arkansas deducts its administrative charges and required rebates, shall be dedicated to and used to provide financial support for any purpose for which the City's general fund may be legally used.

- FOR the levy of Sales and Use Tax
- AGAINST the levy of Sales and Use Tax

#### BALLOT ISSUE

The bonds described below that are approved may be combined into a single issue or may be issued in series from time to time. If the bonds are approved, there will be levied a three-quarters of one percent (0.75%) sales and use tax for the sole purpose of retiring bonds. The net collections of the tax remaining after the State of Arkansas deducts its administrative charges and required rebates will be used solely to retire the bonds and obligations of the City with respect thereto. The rate of taxation will be three-quarters of one percent (0.75%).

FOR or AGAINST an issue of bonds of the City of Sherwood, Arkansas in the maximum principal amount of \$38,500,000 which, together with other available moneys, will finance capital improvements, betterments, and extensions for the City's street system, including but not limited to, the planning, design, inspection, and management of the construction, reconstruction, equipping, and installation of paving and repairing of streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, ditches, drainage facilities, bridges, culverts, pipes, stormwater discharge and detention facilities, and related improvements and the acquisition of necessary rights of way and easements, and, in order to pay the bonds, the levy and pledge of a three-quarters of one percent (0.75%) local sales and use tax within the City if such tax is approved by the voters at this special election.
