The meeting was called to order by Chairman Leonard A. Boyle, Sr. A quorum was determined; all members present.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Motion to table meeting minutes was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commissioner Burks and seconded by Commissioner Parke. All in favor; motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Business

Mr. Camp noted that one provisional ballot in question involved a voter who had been mistakenly transferred to another county due to no fault of her own. David Berman from the Pulaski County Clerk's Office, cleared up the situation and suggested that the vote count.

Motion to count ballot was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commissioner Burks and seconded by Commissioner Parke. All in favor; motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

There were seventeen ballots that were counted on May 20, 2014. The ballot added today brings the total to eighteen. After opening the seventeen provisional ballots previously approved, there was one ballot envelope that did not have the ballot included. This brings the total ballots to be counted to 17.

Anthony Aaron, a Pulaski County Elector, appeared before the commission to dispute the decision of his ballot. David Berman checked voter records for Mr. Aaron.

Because of time constraints and information given on his provisional ballot envelope, Mr. Aaron's ballot could not be counted.

Barry Haas, a Pulaski County Elector, appeared before the commission to dispute the decision of his ballot due to his refusal to present a photo ID. Because of the current Voter ID laws in place, his ballot could not be counted.
