The meeting was called to order by Chairman Walker. A quorum was determined; Commissioner Wyrick absent.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (3/19, 3/22, 4/7)

Motion to approve made by Chairman Walker; seconded by Commissioner Snider. All in favor; motion carried unanimously.

Election races in the General Primary Runoff (6/8/2010) are:

US Senate, US Congress, District 2, Secretary of State, Commissioner of State Lands, State Rep. Dist. 27, State Rep. Dist. 31, State Rep. Dist. 34, and JP Dist. 5.

Precinct 70/72, Pleasant Valley Church of Christ, could not serve as voting precinct for the runoff. This location will be temporarily combined with Precinct 69, First Baptist Church of Little Rock.

Approval of Polling Locations, General Primary Runoff (6/8/2010)

Motion to approve polling locations made by Chairman Walker; seconded by Commissioner Snider. All in favor; motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Election Official Roster, General Primary Runoff (6/8/2010)

Motion to approve election official roster made by Chairman Walker; seconded by Commissioner Snider. All in favor; motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Early Voting Sites, General Primary Runoff (6/8/2010)

Motion to approve all early voting sites made by Chairman Walker; seconded by Commissioner Snider. All in favor; motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Chairman Walker to move into executive session to review provisional ballots from the May 18, 2010 Preferential Primary/Nonpartisan Judicial General Election; seconded by Commissioner Snider. All in favor' motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was reconvened by Chairman Walker. Upon review of provisional ballots, there were a total of 111. There were 68 eligible ballots and 53 ineligible ballots. Notices will be sent to all voters. Ineligible voter's will be given the opportunity to contest the decision of the election commission and county clerk's office tentatively on May 28, 2010 at 4:00 p.m.

Other Business

Because State House District 31 was left off of the Precinct 79, Henderson UMC ballot, voters were given the ballot of precinct 62 which was identical to the ballot at Precinct 79. The plan was to enter all votes for Precinct 79 in manually; that was not possible. The M100 tapes and early vote totals for early voting and election day all balanced and do appear as such on our website. All the votes in both precincts were captured correctly.

Ballots for the General Primary to be tentatively reviewed for approval on Tuesday, May, 24, 2010
