Ronald Poe, an unopposed candidate for Alderman in the City of Wrightsville, has filed to run in Ward 2. However, according to the County Clerk's office, he resides in Ward 1. The County Clerk's office has contacted Mr. Poe. At this point, a judge must decide to prevent his name from being on the ballot. Chairman Walker asked that the County Attorney prepare an opinion and appear at the next board meeting.
