The meeting was called to order by Chairman Leonard A. Boyle, Sr. A quorum was determined; all members present.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes, May 1, 2014**

Motion to table meeting minutes was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commissioner Parke and seconded by Commissioner Burks. All in favor; motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

**Pref Primary/NP General Election, May 20, 2014**

Review of Provisional Ballots

A total of 79 provisional ballots were submitted; 25 were reviewed

- Provisional ballots approved: 45
- Provisional ballots rejected: 34

**Discussion of Voter Authorization Procedures**

Mr. Poe presented the procedures for authorizing voters for the June 10, 2014 General Primary Runoff. Shawn Camp conducts the training of Voter ID Clerks. Procedures are to be taped to table next to poll books. Commissioner Parke requested that Area Managers reiterate procedures on Election Day to Chief Judges and workers. Procedures will be re-evaluated after the election for possible improvement.

Commissioner Burks asked what is being done to reduce the poll worker error rate on voting procedures. Mr. Poe noted several changes have been made to help reduce the

error rate among voters (Voter ID requirements, poll worker opportunities, and improved training of poll workers, speaking engagements). Mr. Berman also stated steps that the County Clerk's office has done to better inform voters about Voter ID requirements (PSAs).

Commissioner Parke suggested contacting voters whose ballots were rejected be notified of their errors in voting absentee.

### **General Primary Runoff Election, June 10, 2014**

#### *Designate Polling Sites/EV Locations*

114 Election Day Sites

8 Early Voting Sites

Motion to approve designated polling sites and early voting locations was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commissioner Parke and seconded by Commission Burks. All in favor; motion was passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### **Certify Ballot Styles**

There were 135 ballot styles for 135 polling locations. There was one contested race on the ballot. Motion to approve ballot styles was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commission Parke and seconded by Commissioner Burks to approve ballot styles. All in favor; motion was passed unanimously by voice vote.

#### **Notice of Election**

Motion to approve Notice of Election was made by Chairman Boyle. It was moved by Commissioner Burks and seconded by Commissioner Parke. All in favor; motion was passed unanimously by voice vote.

June 10, 2012 General Primary Election

May 22, 2012 Preferential Primary/Nonpartisan Judicial General Election
