Notice of Crossover Voting

Notice was reviewed by the board prior to mail out of notifications. There are 50 voters who will be notified from the June 10, 2014 General Primary Runoff Election.

Mr. Poe presented a comprehensive report containing errors, issues and irregularities in the May Primary and June Runoff election at the polls. Each polling location is listed with the errors that occurred on Election Day during each election. A follow up plan will be devised to address these issues with the poll workers.

Mr. Poe noted that he has requested a vendor quote to purchase ePollbooks. Commissioner Burks asked that the commission continue to gather information for future purchase. Mr. Poe suggested making the purchase of ePollbooks in an off election year so that training can be conducted with poll workers and to allow the possibility to work the purchase in the budget.

The next scheduled meeting will be Friday, July 11, 2014 to conduct the Ballot Position Drawing for candidates in the Annual School Election on September 16, 2014.
