The SBEC recently met regarding revised rules for 2015. A thirty-day comment period was opened for the public. Mr. Poe submitted some language to the state board initially and plans on meeting with the board, along with a county attorney, to finalize that language and make a proposal before the state board during public comment regarding the provisional ballot process by the county commission.

Precinct 25, Indian Hills Church, has been sold. However, they have agreed to allow the commission usage of the facility until the end of 2016.

During equipment delivery this week, one of the delivery drivers ran into the awing on the building of First Church of the Nazarene and cause some minor damage. We will be filing a claim with insurance to make the repairs.

Mr. Poe prepared the precinct order to comply with Act 1211 of 2013. He has submitted it to the County Attorney to review the language and will be submitted to the county board to certify at the election certification meeting.

The Arkansas County Election Commissioners Association (ACECA) will be meeting on August 25, 2015. There will be a panel discussion regarding conducting early voting and a couple of our staff members will be involved on the panel.

John Walker, attorney for the Joshua Interveners, has filed a motion in Federal Court to shut down the Jacksonville School District election. The hearing is scheduled on July 20, 2015. At this point, there is no action to be taken by the board.

Mr. Poe is still working on the narrative for the November 2014 General Election.

The hearing for the city incorporation of Little Italy was postponed today in circuit court.

Mr. Donald Bryant attempted to make a request of the board today. It was not clear as to what he was requesting. The board asked that he present his request in writing so they could be clear as to what he is asking the board to act on his behalf.

The scheduled time for the meeting on July 16, 2015 has been changed to 4:00 p.m. Commissioner Gorman asked that the meeting be set up in FaceTime since Commissioner Boyle will be meeting by teleconference.
