*Little Rock School District (LRSD) Special Election, May 9, 2017*

Preliminary Review of Provisional Ballots

There were 64 provisional ballots for review.

- Eight (8) were unsigned by the voter
- Nineteen (19) were determined eligible
- Thirty-one (31) were determined ineligible

Commissioner Boyle moved to approve the preliminary findings of eligibility of provisional ballots; seconded by Commissioner Harris-Ritter. Motion passed by voice vote.

Approval to Adopt Resolution Regarding Selection of Early Vote Sites

Commission Harris-Ritter moved to adopt resolution; seconded by Commissioner Boyle. Motion passed by voice vote.

### **OTHER BUSINESS**

Correspondence was received from Kelly Boyd, Chief Deputy, Secretary of State regarding funding for voting equipment. The letter states that when funding is available the state will match dollar for dollar with Pulaski County when available. Still, at this time, it is not known when funding will be available for either the state or the county.

Next meeting is scheduled for May 18, 2017 at 5:00 to hear from voters contesting the decision of provisional ballots and to certify the final election results of the May 9, 2017 LRSD Special Election.
