## **Other Business**

### *New Poll Worker Application*

The current poll worker application is in the process of being revamped for the office to obtain more information from applicants. The Commissioners gave some suggestions regarding the formatting and information on the application.

### *State Board of Election Commission Complaints for 2018 Elections*

Case number 2018-036 concerned the use of a University of Arkansas at Little Rock Student ID as a form of identification by a voter in the December 4, 2018 General Election. Upon review of their notes, the election officials determined this was an acceptable form of ID. Voter was able to vote.

Case number 2018-038 concerned the use of a provisional ballot for a voter that was sent an absentee ballot for the November 6, 2018 General Election. The voter applied for a Uniform Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) in 2016, which is effective for four years. The voter failed to notify the Circuit/County Clerk's office upon return to the state. Voter was provided with a provisional ballot. Upon review it was determined that the voter didn't receive the UOCAVA ballot and the provisional ballot was counted.
