District compactness is best with Alternatives 6 and 4, though 4a is not too divergent. In terms of spatial measures, Alternative 5 misses the mark on population balance, compactness, and contiguity. On these measures alone, this alternative should be discarded.</p> <p>The final criteria for redistricting is based on maintaining communities of interest. In that sense, redistricting must acknowledge the presence of existing neighborhoods and attempt to hold together communities in whatever way feasible. In a practical sense, it isn't possible to maintain all neighborhoods and communities; lines and boundaries, however carefully drawn, by design must divide one adjacent area from another. However, all attempts should be made to maintain neighborhoods whenever possible. Based on the final criteria, Alternative 4a rises to the top position, with modifications to several boundaries in Alternative 4 to maintain neighborhood continuity. In a similar way, but in the opposite direction, Alternative 5 drops to the last position. The district lines divide far too many portions of Little Rock and Pulaski County. In my own neighborhood of Leawood, Alternative 5 would place my family in a different district from my neighbors directly across the street. I have reviewed ALL of the map alternatives made by Metroplan that you have presented to the public for review and comment.</p> <p>I must first state that the fact that you presented those blurry, poorly made maps to the public without ANY REQUIRED VRA data, or any other metadata, attached is a total failure of your duties as election commissioners to ensure that the public has ALL of the information that they need to even make relevant comments on these choices presented.</p> <p>My team invested several days recreating these maps solely based on our knowledge of the layout of Pulaski County. Once we finished this task, we looked at the metadata and found that four of the maps can be labeled as violations of the Voting Rights Act and would probably survive a properly brought court challenge.
